OPP INVESTIGATING FATAL COLLISION IN MIDDLESEX CENTRE

(MIDDLESEX CENTRE, ON) - Middlesex County OPP investigating a fatal collision in Middlesex Centre.

On March 5, 2026, at 7:40 p.m., emergency services including members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), Middlesex-London Paramedic Service and Middlesex Centre Fire, were dispatched to Highbury Avenue North between Thirteen and Fourteen Mile Roads in the Municipality of Middlesex Centre, for the report of a serious, head-on collision involving two vehicles.

The drivers and lone occupants of both vehicles were transported to hospital with life-threatening-injuries.

As a result of the collision both drivers, a 75-year-old of St. Thomas and a 28-year-old of Georgian Bluffs, were pronounced deceased at the hospital.

Members of the OPP Traffic Incident Management Enforcement (TIME) team are on scene to assist with the investigation.

YOUTH CHARGED AFTER DISTURBANCE IN ARVA

(MIDDLESEX CENTRE, ON) - Youth facing charges after disturbance in Arva.

On March 3, 2026, at 1:03 p.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), were dispatched to 14405 Medway Road in Arva, Municipality of Middlesex Centre, for the report of a disturbance.

Officers arrived on scene however most of the involved individuals dispersed prior to police arrival.

Investigation identified a person of interest at which time that individual was placed under arrest and transported to the Middlesex OPP Detachment.

As a result, a 15-year-old of London, has been charged under the Criminal Code with: Assault with A Weapon, Possession of Weapon for Dangerous Purpose Assault

The accused has been released from police custody and is scheduled to appear in the Ontario Court of Justice at a future date to speak to the charges.

The youth's identity is protected under the Youth Criminal Justice Act (YCJA).

The investigation is continuing.

INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE INVESTIGATION RESULTS IN CHARGES

(MIDDLESEX CENTRE, ON) - Intimate partner investigation leads to charges.

On March 10, 2026, at 4:57 p.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) were dispatched to an address on Gideon Drive in the Municipality of Middlesex Centre the report of an intimate partner violence complaint.

As a result, a 53-year-old of Middlesex County, has been charged under the Criminal Code with: Criminal Harassment - repeatedly follow, repeatedly communicate with, watch and beset, threatening conduct, Sexual Assault

The accused has been released from police custody and is scheduled to appear in the Ontario Court of Justice at a future date to speak to the charges.

INDIVIDUAL FROM ST. THOMAS CHARGED WITH FRAUD IN MIDDLESEX CENTRE

(MIDDLESEX CENTRE, ON) - A resident of St. Thomas has been charged with fraud after an investigation in Middlesex Centre.

On January 9, 2026, at 1:31 p.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) were dispatched to a business on Jefferies Road, in the Municipality of Middlesex Centre, for the report of a fraud.

Investigation revealed an employee of the business had reportedly cashed fraudulent cheques totalling just under \$45,000.

As a result, a 60-year-old of St. Thomas, has been charged with: Fraud Over \$5000, Use, deals, acts on forged document

The accused has been released from police custody and is scheduled to appear in the Ontario Court of Justice in London on May 11, 2026, to speak to the charges.

INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE INVESTIGATION RESULTS IN MISCHIEF CHARGE

(SOUTHWEST MIDDLESEX, ON) - Domestic assault investigation in the Municipality of Southwest Middlesex results in mischief charge.

On March 18, 2026, at 2:48 p.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) were dispatched to an address in Newbury, Municipality of Southwest Middlesex for the report of a disturbance.

As a result of the investigation, a 53-year-old of Southwest Middlesex has been charged under the Criminal Code with: Mischief - Domestic

The accused was released from police custody and is scheduled to attend the Ontario Court of Justice in London at a future date to speak to the charges.

INDIVIDUAL FROM EXETER CHARGED WITH FRAUD IN NORTH MIDDLESEX

(NORTH MIDDLESEX, ON) - A resident of Exeter has been charged with fraud after an investigation in North Middlesex.

On January 23, 2026, at 10:56 a.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) were dispatched to a business on Parkhill King Street, in Parkhill, the Municipality of North Middlesex, for the report of a fraud.

Investigation revealed an employee of the business had reportedly cashed fraudulent cheques totalling just over \$107,000.

As a result, a 39-year-old of Exeter, has been charged with: Fraud Over \$5000, Criminal Breach of Trust, Falsification books and documents - fraudulent intent

The accused has been released from police custody and is scheduled to appear in the Ontario Court of Justice in London on May 26, 2026, to speak to the charges.

YOUTH CHARGED WITH MISCHIEF IN ILDERTON

(MIDDLESEX CENTRE, ON) - One youth has been charged after a disturbance in Ilderton.

On March 19, 2026, at 10:28 p.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) were dispatched to an address on Willow Ridge Road in Ilderton, Municipality of Middlesex Centre for the report of a disturbance.

Investigation revealed a group of youth approached the front door of the residence and proceeded to kick the door.

As a result, a 15-year-old of St. Mary's was taken into custody without incident and charged with Mischief under \$ 5,000, Obstruct Peace Officer and Trespassing at Night under the Criminal Code.

The youth has been released from police custody and is scheduled to attend the Ontario Court in London to speak to the charges.

The youth's identity is protected under the Youth Criminal Justice Act (YCJA).
