(21 Jan- 19 Feb) A conflict at home may arise when the neighbour catches you burgling their house. I didn't say it was your home.

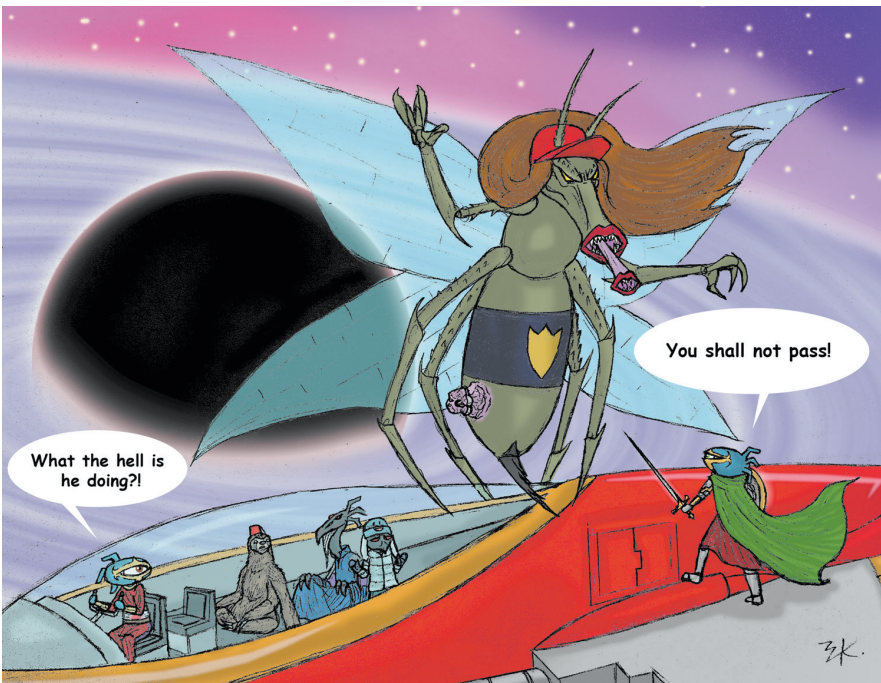


(24 Aug- 23 Sept) A single thought can lead us down the path to absurdity. So, no, I don't think you should buy that NFT, Gary.
