SINGLE VEHICLE COLLISION LEADS TO IMPAIRED CHARGE

(MIDDLESEX CENTRE, ON) - Driver facing Impaired driving charge after single vehicle collision in Middlesex Centre.

On April 9, 2026, at 11:22 p.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) were dispatched to Vanneck Road at Medway Road in the Municipality of Middlesex Centre, for the report of a single vehicle collision.

The driver was placed under arrest and transported to the Middlesex County OPP Detachment.

As a result, a 46-year-old of London, has been charged under the Criminal Code with: Operation while impaired - Alcohol, Operation while impaired - blood alcohol concentration (80 plus), Dangerous Operation

The accused has been released from police custody and is scheduled to appear in the Ontario Court of Justice in London to speak to the charges on May 11, 2026.

TRAFFIC STOP LEADS TO IMPAIRED DRIVER

(SOUTHWEST MIDDLESEX, ON) - Driver facing Impaired charge after traffic stop in Southwest Middlesex.

On April 11, 2026, at 1:26 a.m., a member of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) while on general patrol in the Municipality of Southwest Middlesex, observed a suspicious vehicle on Hagerty Road.

A traffic stop was initiated at which time the driver was placed under arrest and transported to the Middlesex OPP Detachment.

As a result, an 18-year-old of Newbury, has been charged under the Criminal Code and Cannabis Control Act with: Operation While Impaired - Alcohol and Drugs, Operation while impaired - blood alcohol concentration (80 plus), Dangerous Operation, Drive vehicle or boat with cannabis readily available

The accused has been released from police custody and is scheduled to appear in the Ontario Court of Justice in London to speak to the charges on May 26, 2026.

OPP INVESTIGATING BREAK & ENTER TO BUSINESS IN SOUTHWEST MIDDLESEX

(SOUTHWEST MIDDLESEX, ON) - Middlesex County OPP investigating break and enter to a business in Southwest Middlesex.

On April 12, 2026, at 3:16 a.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), were dispatched to a business at 6419 Longwoods Road, Municipality of Southwest Middlesex, for the report of break and enter.

Investigation revealed an unknown individual(s) gained entry to the business through the front door, between 1:27 and 1:57 a.m. on April 12. A window was smashed on the door as a result.

A small amount of Canadian currency was reported stolen.

The suspect has been described to be wearing all black with a mask.

The investigation is continuing.

OPP ARE INVESTIGATING A BREAK-IN AND ROBBERY IN MIDDLESEX AND LAMBTON COUNTY

(WARWICK, ON) - Members of the Lambton County Detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) along side of members with the Middlesex County Detachment of the OPP are investigating a break-in in North Middlesex and robbery, in Warwick Township.

On April 9, 2026, at 2:59 a.m., members of the Middlesex Detachment of the OPP were dispatched to a business on Elginfield Road in Parkhill, Municipality of North Middlesex, for the report of break and enter.

The investigation revealed an unknown individual(s) gained entry to the business through a drive-thru window, between 1:30 and 1:45 a.m. on April 9.

At approximately 3:55 a.m., members of the Lambton County OPP were dispatched to a business on Confederation Line in Warwick Township for a reported robbery where one individual was located inside the business.

The individual fled the scene and remains outstanding.

The suspect is described as:

- Approximately 5'9" - 6'0" tall
- Wearing dark coloured pants
- A black ski mask
- Brown eyes

The investigation remains ongoing.

A YOUTH FROM NORTH MIDDLESEX IS FACING MULTIPLE FRAUD CHARGES

(NORTH MIDDLESEX, ON) - A youth from North Middlesex is facing multiple charges after separate fraud investigations in Parkhill.

On January 13, 2026, at 9:42 a.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) were dispatched to an address on John Street, in Parkhill, the Municipality of North Middlesex, for the report of a fraud. Investigation revealed the victims debit card had been fraudulently used by an unknown individual totalling nearly \$1,000 in expenses.

On January 23, 2026, at 11:16 a.m., members of the Middlesex County OPP were dispatched to an address on Duke Street in Parkhill, for the report of a fraud, where investigation revealed the victims debit card had been fraudulently used by an unknown individual totalling nearly \$2,000 in expenses.

As a result, members of the Middlesex County Integrated Fraud Awareness and Response Initiative (IFARI) were engaged to assist with the investigations.

As a result of the investigation, a 17-year-old of Parkhill, was identified and has been charged under the criminal code with: Fraud Under \$5000 (two counts), Use of Credit Card (two counts), Possession Property Obtained by Crime Under \$5,000 (two counts)

The accused has been released from police custody and is scheduled to appear in the Ontario Court of Justice in London at a future date to speak to the charges. The youth's identity is protected under the Youth Criminal Justice Act (YCJA).

FATAL COLLISION CLOSES MELBOURNE ROAD

(SOUTHWEST MIDDLESEX, ON) - A cyclist has died as a result of being struck by a vehicle on Melbourne Road in the Municipality of Southwest Middlesex.

On May 4, 2026, at 12:17 p.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), Oneida Nation Police, Strathroy-Caradoc Police Service, Middlesex-London Paramedic Service and local Fire, were dispatched to Melbourne Road between Inadale and Olde Drives in the Municipality of Southwest Middlesex for the report of a collision involving a vehicle and a cyclist.

The cyclist, a 25-year-old of Southwest Middlesex was transported to hospital where they were later pronounced deceased.

The driver of the vehicle was transported to hospital as a precaution.

INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE INVESTIGATION RESULTS IN CHARGES

(SOUTHWEST MIDDLESEX, ON) - Domestic assault investigation in the Municipality of Southwest Middlesex results in charges.

On April 26, 2026, at 11:25 p.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) were dispatched to an address in Glencoe, Municipality of Southwest Middlesex for the report of a disturbance.

As a result of the investigation two involved individuals were placed under arrest and transported to the Middlesex OPP detachment.

A 28-year-old of Southwest Middlesex has been charged with under the Criminal Code.: Assault Cause Bodily Harm - Choke, suffocate or strangle

A 26-year-old of Southwest Middlesex has been charged under the Criminal Code with: Assault with a Weapon - Spousal (two counts), Assault with A Weapon, Spousal (three counts), Mischief - destroys or damages property, Uttering Threats - Cause death or Bodily Harm-Spousal

The accused were released from police custody and are scheduled to attend the Ontario Court of Justice in London at a future date to speak to the charges.
