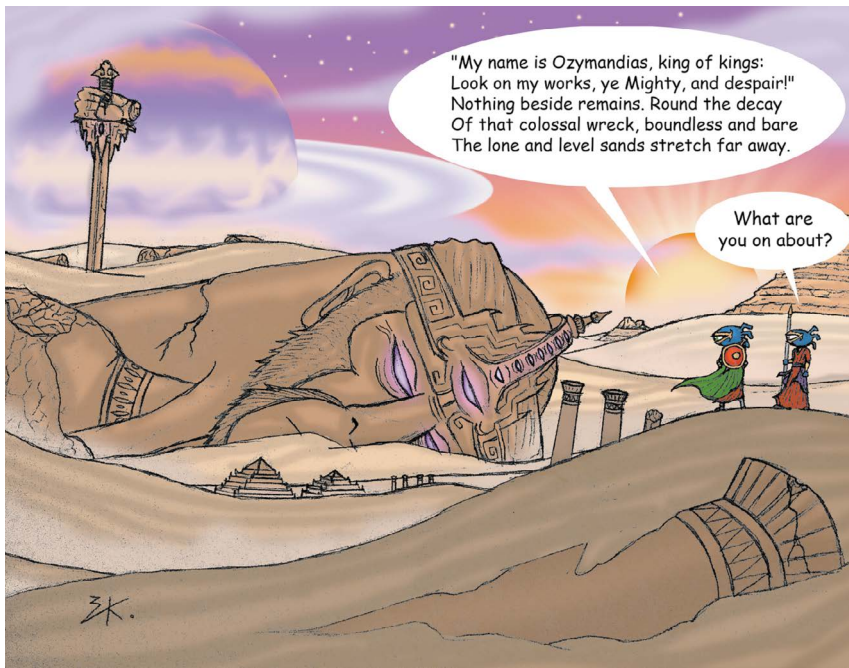


(21 Jan- 19 Feb) You may have felt your health improving lately as you get more active, or possibly the opposite if you aren't.
