SUSPENDED DRIVER FACING MULTIPLE CHARGES

(MIDDLESEX CENTRE, ON) - In-car camera alert results in suspended driver.

On July 28, 2026, at 4:39 p.m., a Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) member, while on general patrol on Westdel Bourne in the Municipality of Middlesex Centre, was alerted by the Automated Licence Plate Recognition (ALPR) system, of a vehicle possibly being operated with unattached licence plates.

A traffic stop was initiated at which time the driver exited the vehicle and attempted to evade police.

Police confirmed the licence plates were not registered on the vehicle and the driver was suspended at which time the driver was placed under arrest.

As a result, a 32-year-old of London, has been charged under Highway Traffic Act, Trespass to Property Act and Compulsory Automobile Insurance Act with: Use plate not authorized for vehicle, Driving while under suspension, Enter premises when entry prohibited, Owner operate a motor vehicle without insurance

The accused has been released from police custody and is scheduled to appear in the Ontario Provincial Traffic Court to speak to the charges at a later date.

G1 DRIVER CHARGED AFTER TRAFFIC STOP ON HIGHWAY 401

(THAMES CENTRE, ON) - A G1 driver has been charged after traffic stop on Highway 401.

On August 3, 2026, at 8:18 a.m., a member of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) while performing a speed enforcement initiative in the eastbound lanes of Highway 401 in the Municipality of Thames Centre, observed a vehicle travelling in excess of the posted 100km/h speed limit. A traffic stop was initiated.

As a result, a 42-year-old of London, has been charged under the Highway Traffic Act and Compulsory Automobile Insurance Act with: Speeding 1 - 49 Km/h over posted limit, Class G1 licence holder - unaccompanied by qualified driver, Class G1 licence holder - carry front-seat passenger, Drive while passenger under 16 fails to properly wear a seat belt, Fail to surrender permit for motor vehicle, Fail to surrender insurance card

The accused was released from police custody and is scheduled to appear in the Ontario Provincial Traffic Court in London to speak to the charges at a later date.

MIDDLESEX OPP INVESTIGATING A HOME INVASION IN THAMES CENTRE

(THAMES CENTRE, ON) - Middlesex County OPP investigating a home invasion in Thames Centre.

On August 5, 2026, at approximately 7:34 a.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) responded to the report of a vehicle fire on Rebecca Road in the Municipality of Thames Centre.

Investigation revealed the burned-out vehicle belonged to an individual not far from the scene. Officers attended the registered owner's residence on Nissouri Road and were met by the owner who was suffering from injuries.

It was determined that several unknown individuals forcefully entered the residence and confronted the lone occupant inside. The occupant received minor injuries following an altercation with the suspects.

The suspects proceeded to steal the homeowner's vehicle and fled the scene.

BREAK AND ENTER INVESTIGATION TO NEW BUILDS IN ILDERTON

(MIDDLESEX CENTRE, ON) - Middlesex OPP investigating multiple break-ins to homes under construction in Ilderton.

On August 9, 2026, at 3:14 p.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), were dispatched to a construction site on Woodmere Path in Ilderton, Municipality of Middlesex Centre, for the report of multiple break and enters.

It was determined an unknown individual(s) broke into three separate homes under construction, sometime during the overnight hours and proceeded to steal miscellaneous tools.

The investigation is continuing.

OPP RIDE PROGRAM LEADS TO DRUG SEIZURE

(Approximately \$70,00 to \$80,000 worth of Dried Cannabis Seized)

(MIDDLESEX CENTRE, ON) - OPP RIDE program leads to large cannabis seizure.

On July 27, 2026, at 2:21 p.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) were performing a Reduce Impaired Driving Everywhere (RIDE) Program on Southminster Bourne in the Municipality of Middlesex Centre.

A vehicle attempted to elude the RIDE Program at which time a traffic stop was initiated.

The driver of the vehicle was placed under arrest.

A search of the vehicle revealed multiple packages of illegal cannabis products with an estimated street value between \$70,000 and \$80,000.

As a result, a 30-year-old of North York, has been charged under the Cannabis Act, Cannabis Control Act, Highway Traffic Act and Compulsory Automobile Insurance Act with: Possession of over 30g dried cannabis (or equivalent) in a public place, Possession for the purpose of distributing, Drive vehicle or boat with cannabis readily available, Driving while under suspension, Fail to surrender required documents, Drive motor vehicle - no licence, Fail to have insurance card

The accused was released from police custody and is scheduled to attend the Ontario Court of Justice in London on September 11, 2026, to speak to the charges.

INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE INVESTIGATION RESULTS IN CHARGE

(NORTH MIDDLESEX, ON) - Intimate partner violence investigation in North Middlesex results in assault charge.

On August 13, 2026, at 12:47 a.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) were dispatched to an address in North Middlesex, for the report of a disturbance.

As a result, a 28-year-old of North Middlesex has been charged under the Criminal Code with: Assault - Spousal

The accused has been released from police custody and is scheduled to attend the Ontario Court of Justice in London at a later time.

There were no injuries reported.

OPP INVESTIGATING MISCHIEF COMPLAINTS IN AILSA CRAIG

(Wheel Nuts Loosened and Removed from Vehicles)

(NORTH MIDDLESEX, ON) - Middlesex County OPP investigating multiple complaints of mischief throughout Ailsa Craig after vehicle owners reported loose or missing wheel nuts on their tires.

On August 11, 2026, members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), received multiple complaints from residents in Ailsa Craig in the Municipality of North Middlesex advising the wheel nuts on their wheels had either been loosened or removed.

Two unidentified individuals were observed on video surveillance tampering with the wheel nuts on a vehicle.

Middlesex OPP suggests residents in an around the area check their wheel nuts and ensure they have not been tampered with.

The investigation is continuing.

SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS UNIT INVOKES MANDATE IN NORTH MIDDLESEX

(NORTH MIDDLESEX, ON) - The Special Investigations Unit (SIU) has invoked its mandate following a collision involving an Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) cruiser in the Municipality of North Middlesex.

On Sunday, August 23, 2026, at approximately 3:30 p.m., members of the Middlesex County OPP, Middlesex-London Paramedic Service, and North Middlesex Fire Services responded to a serious two-vehicle collision at the intersection of Nairn Road and Centre Road involving a passenger vehicle and an OPP cruiser.

The driver of the passenger vehicle and an OPP officer were transported to hospital with serious injuries.

BOAT AND TRAILER STOLEN IN SOUTHWEST MIDDLESEX

(SOUTHWEST MIDDLESEX, ON) - Middlesex County OPP investigating the theft of boat and trailer in Southwest Middlesex.

On August 19, 2026, at 6:55 a.m., members of the Middlesex County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), were dispatched to an address on Irish Drive in the Municipality of Southwest Middlesex for the report of a theft.

It was determined an unknown individual(s) entered the property sometime during the overnight hours and proceeded to steal a Blue and Silver 2017 Starweld Victory 20 DC boat and trailer.

The investigation is continuing.
